Social Services and Older Adult Services are restricted to an area in the Kansas City, Missouri inner-city from approximately 18th to 43rd streets north to south, and Blue River Road to Brooklyn Avenue, east to west. Seton Center food pantry hours are 9 am to 2:45 pm - Monday through Friday, closed weekends. Applicants must bring a social security card for each household member, utility bill or rent agreement as proof of address, proof of income, picture I.D., and a list of income and expenses.</p>
